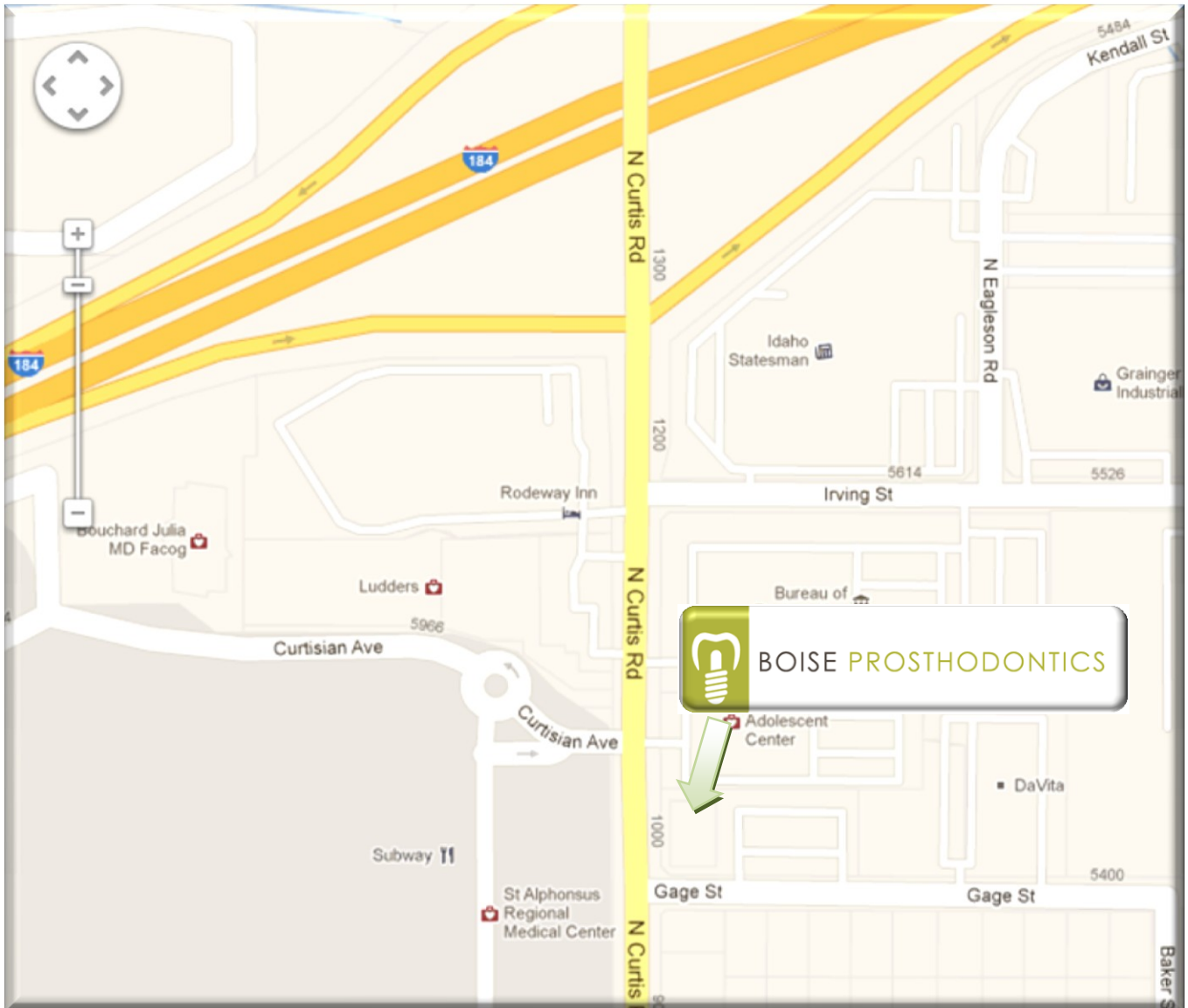

Complex dental treatment often requires additional information to engineer a predictable definitive treatment plan. Thus, a definitive treatment plan may not be presented until all needed information and treatment coordination is completed. Our goal is to engineer a treatment plan that is predicable and successful long term, which will meet your expectations.

### **I-184 Connector**

1. Take I-184 Connector toward downtown Boise
2. Take Exit 2 – Curtis Road
3. Turn Right onto Curtis Road
4. Building 1000 is on the left side of the road directly across from St. Alphonsus Regional Medical Center
5. Turn Left onto Gage Street
6. Parking for Building 1000 is immediately on your left

7. Take the elevator to the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, we're in room 203
